## Rebuy Rules

- \$10 Rebuys may be purchased anytime a player is at or below the starting chip amount of \$2,000
- A player losing all of their chips may purchase a single or a double rebuy.
- Players are encouraged to purchase their re-buys in casino chips
- A staff add-on may be purchased at the completion of the rebuy period regardless of chip stack. The add-on is \$10 for \$5,000 in Chips

### GENERAL RULES

1. \$20 Buy-In players start with \$2,000 in chips.
2. \$10 Re-buys are permitted anytime a player is at or below \$2,000 in tournament chips. A player will receive \$2000 in tournament chips for their re-buy. A player who has been felted may purchase a \$10 single re-buy and receive \$2,000 in chips, or they may purchase a double re-buy for \$20 and receive \$4,000 in chips.
3. A Player who is felted must state his intent to re-buy prior to the start of the next hand or they will be eliminated.
4. At the completion of the re-buy period a player may purchase a one time staff add-on for \$10 and receive \$5,000 in tournament chips. All add-ons are withheld for the tournament staff.
5. TDA rules apply to all poker tournaments held at Delaware Park.
6. Delaware Park reserves the right to alter, modify, or cancel a tournament at its discretion.
7. Seating may be limited.
9. 10 minute break at the completion of every 3 levels.
10. Winners will be paid in casino chips.

8. Alternates are permitted until the end of the first break. Alternates are eligible to receive a refund up until the time that their chips stack is put in play. Once an alternate is registered for the tournament, they are entitled to a seat in the event even if their seat does not become available until after the close of registration. Late entries that require a new stack of chips to be put in play will have the equivalent of three small blinds extracted from their chip stack. The amount of one small blind will be placed into the first three pots the new stack is dealt into.
11. The tournament prize pool disbursement as set forth herein may be modified upon unanimous written agreement of all tournament players still involved in the tournament.
12. Residents of foreign countries without a U.S. tax treaty will be subject to withholding.
13. Tournament director's decisions are final.
14. 5% of the prize pool will be withheld for the tournament staff.
15. Refer to the tournament calendar for time starts and any promotions for this tournament.
16. Special Events as listed on the event calendar will be held in lieu of regularly scheduled events.
17. Free Seats will be awarded to select events as listed on tournament calendar. Refer to the free tournament seat promotion for official rules.
